

- Abstracts of case report will have the heading 'Report' instead of 'Objectives', 'Methods' and 'Results'.
- Abstracts must be accompanied by payment of registration fees. If the abstracts is subsequently
  not accepted for presentation, the registration fees will be refunded to the author in accordance
  with the cancellation policy.
- Scheduling details and guidelines for the final preparation of accepted presentations will be included with the notification of acceptance.
- The final selection will be the responsibility of the Scientific Committee.

- Deadline for submission of Abstracts: 14th May 2023
- Selected posters will require the presenter to participate in a 3 minutes poster discussion and 2 minutes Q&A.
